

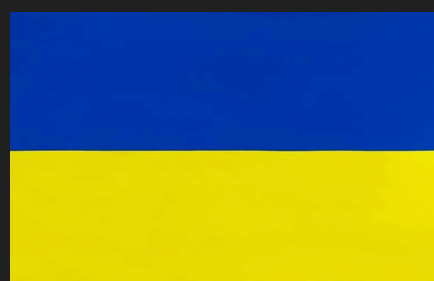

Ukraine's energy infrastructure has been crippled by Russian attacks, plummeting forecasted GDP growth and exacerbating the humanitarian crisis.
